



Young Farmer Receives Kubota as Prize

NEW IPSWICH, NH - The 2010 NH Farm Bureau Young Farmer Achievement Award winner, Ben Cargill was presented the keys to his new Kubota tractor this past Tuesday.

Ben is the owner operator of Cargill Commodities Farm in New Ipswich. He was awarded the NH Young Farmer Achievement Award at the NH Farm Bureau Federation annual meeting held November 11, 2010 in Manchester.

"I will be using the tractor for a variety of tasks around the farm," said Ben. "I've got a long to-do list."

Ben received the use of a Kubota M5700 tractor with loader for six months or 250 hours, whichever comes first. Pinnacleview Equipment Treasurer, Mike Snide, presented the tractor to Ben, the morning of Tuesday, May 17.

This generous prize is made possible by Kubota Tractor Corporation and Pinnacleview Equipment in Walpole, NH. They have been presenting tractors to NH Farm Bureau Young Farmer Achievement Award winners since 1992.

"This was the first state to begin the partnership with Kubota," said Snide. "We are proud supporters of the Young Farmer program."

Contestants for the Achievement Award must be members in good standing with their county Farm Bureaus and actively engaged in farming with the majority of income coming from production agriculture. The state winners are chosen based on their efforts in production agriculture, growth and progress of the farm as well as their Farm Bureau involvement.
