All members receive our bimonthly publication, *The Communicator*. Those who want to stay informed with the legislative happenings can sign up to receive *The Friday Review*, published Fridays during the legislative session (January thru June). *The Post* is a weekly e-newsletter containing NH agricultural events and workshops.

Farm Bureau works closely with state and national policy makers on important issues like property rights, land use regulation, taxes, renewable energy, and more.


